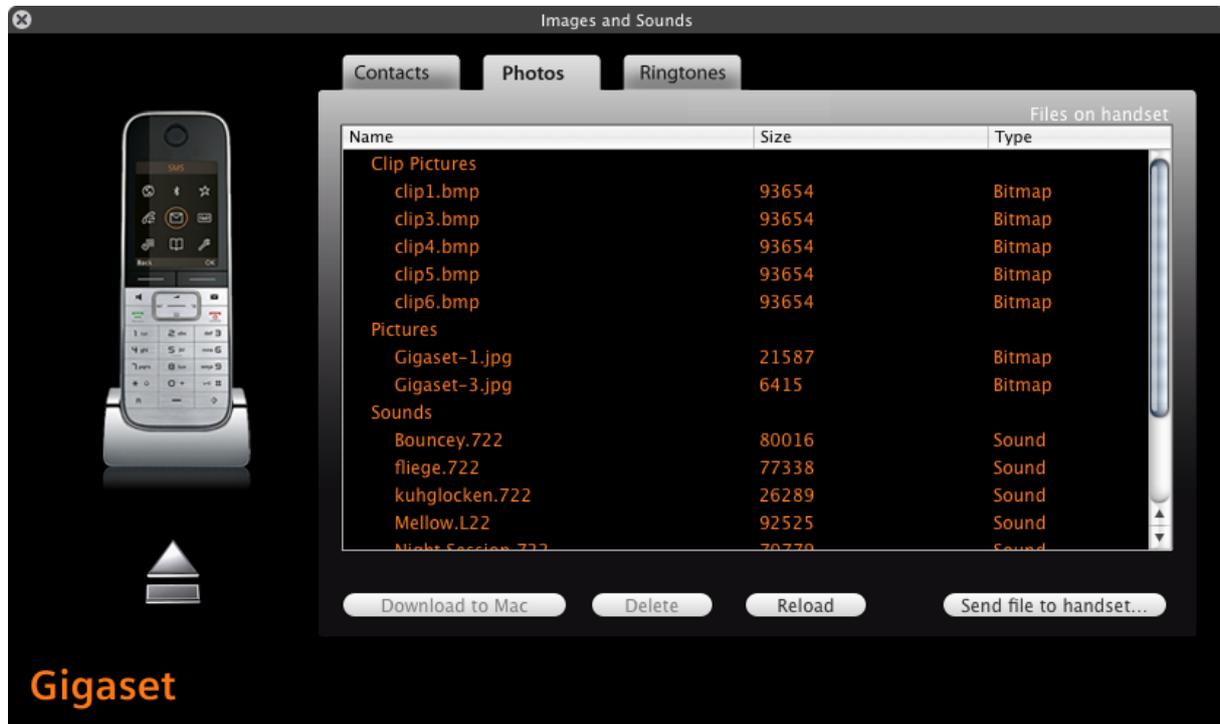


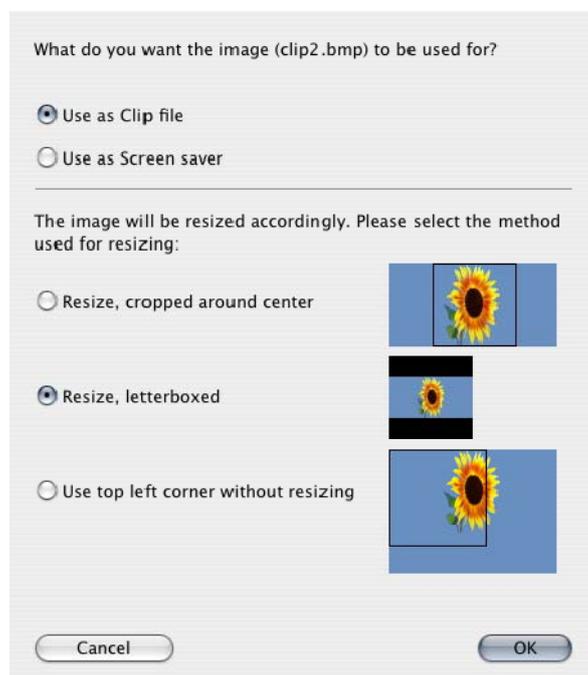
Transferring screensavers and caller ID images

You can select any photo or image file and transfer it to your handset as screensavers or caller ID images. All formats supported by the Mac (BMP, GIF, JPEG, TIFF etc.) are also supported here.

- Click on the "Photos" tab to open the file browser list



- Drag the image file from the Mac to the file browser list. Alternatively, click "Send file to handset..." and then select the image file on the Mac
- In the subsequent window, select whether you would like the image to be used as a screensaver or a caller ID image and specify the method for image adjustment



You can select the following methods for image adjustment:

- **Resize and crop the centre** — The image is cropped and resized to make the central part of the image completely fill the handset display
 - **Resize without cropping** — The image is resized so that it fills the handset display without changing the image proportions
 - **Top left-hand corner, no resizing** — The image is cropped to the size of the handset display and the top left-hand section of the original image is used
- Click "OK" to transfer the image to the handset.

Please note

As part of the transfer process, the images are always converted and saved on your handset in BMP format.

Long filenames are shortened to 16 characters during the transfer process.

If the data transfer is aborted as a result of a device communication error, click "Reload" to restart the process.

Attention

The handset must be in idle status for data transfers.
