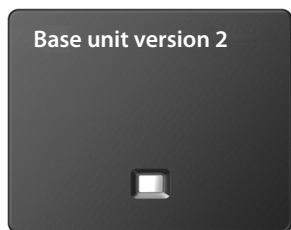


**!** If you want to use your new SL910H handset with an existing SL910-SL910A system, please follow the instructions below.



## Step 1 — Check the firmware versions

Which firmware version is running on your existing handset?

- ▶ With the device in idle mode, touch the battery icon  in the status bar.
- ▶ Touch **Show Service Info**.
- ▶ The firmware version is in line 4, positions 3 to 5.



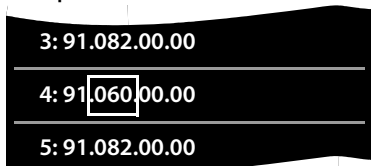
Which firmware version is running on your base unit?

- ▶ With the device in idle mode, **press and hold** .
- ▶ Touch the battery icon  in the status bar.
- ▶ The firmware version is in line 4, positions 3 to 5.

**Requirement:** To update your base unit's firmware, you need an SL910H handset with a firmware version of 69 or lower.

## Step 2 — Prepare the base

You don't have to update the firmware.  
No further action is required.

1. Connect the base unit to the LAN and Internet.
2. Update the firmware using the existing MT910H handset:
  - ▶ Menu key  ▶ Menu page **Settings**
  - ▶ [] **System** ▶ **Firmware Update**
  - ▶ **Update Firmware** ▶ Enter the system PIN (factory setting: 0000) and touch  to confirm. ▶ Follow the instructions displayed.

## Step 3 — Prepare the SL910H handset

- ▶ In the device menu of **Gigaset QuickSync**, click **Firmware update**
- ▶ Click **Update** .

- ▶ In **Gigaset QuickSync**, click **Help** ▶ **Check for updates**

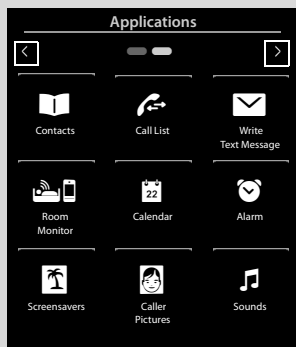
- ▶ Follow the instructions displayed.

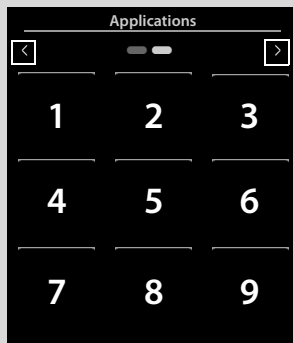
## Step 4 — Update the base unit's firmware

1. Connect the base unit to the LAN and Internet.
2. Enter the update file name:
  - ▶ Menu key  ▶ Mentally assign the numbers 1 to 9 to the first 9 icons on the menu page in lines (as shown below).



Like this:



▶ Enter the numeric code: Press the icons corresponding to the following numbers **for around 2 seconds each**:



**1 4 7 2 3 6 5 9 8.**

▶ A numeric input box appears. Enter the code **81**.

▶ A text input box appears.

Enter the file name **update.gigaset.net/sl910** and touch  to confirm.

3. Update the firmware:

▶ Menu button  ▶ Menu page **Settings** ▶ [ **System**] ▶ **Firmware Update**

▶ **Update Firmware** ▶ Enter the system PIN (factory setting: 0000) and touch  to confirm. ▶ Follow the instructions displayed.

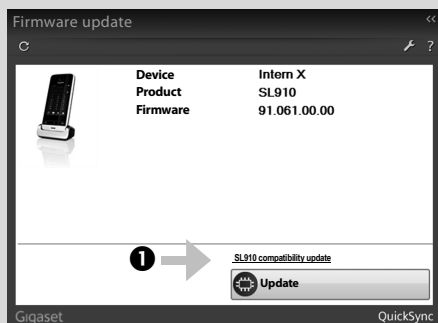
## Step 5 — Update the SL910H handset

Update your handset's firmware using the **Gigaset QuickSync** software (PC: Version 8.2 or higher, MAC: Version 3.0.2 or higher; free download and more information at [www.gigaset.com/gigasetSL910](http://www.gigaset.com/gigasetSL910)).

- ▶ Use this program to set up a USB connection between your computer and handset.

### PC

- ▶ In the device menu of **Gigaset QuickSync**, click **Firmware update**
- ▶ Click "SL910 compatibility update" **1** and then click **Next** each time it subsequently appears.



- ▶ Follow the instructions displayed.

### MAC

- ▶ Enter **update.gigaset.net/910h.bin** in the address bar of your browser (e.g. Safari) and download the file onto your computer.
- ▶ In **Gigaset QuickSync**, click ▶ **Help** ▶ **Firmware Update from File**
- ▶ Select the file you downloaded, and follow the instructions displayed.

**Register all other handsets to the base unit again.**
