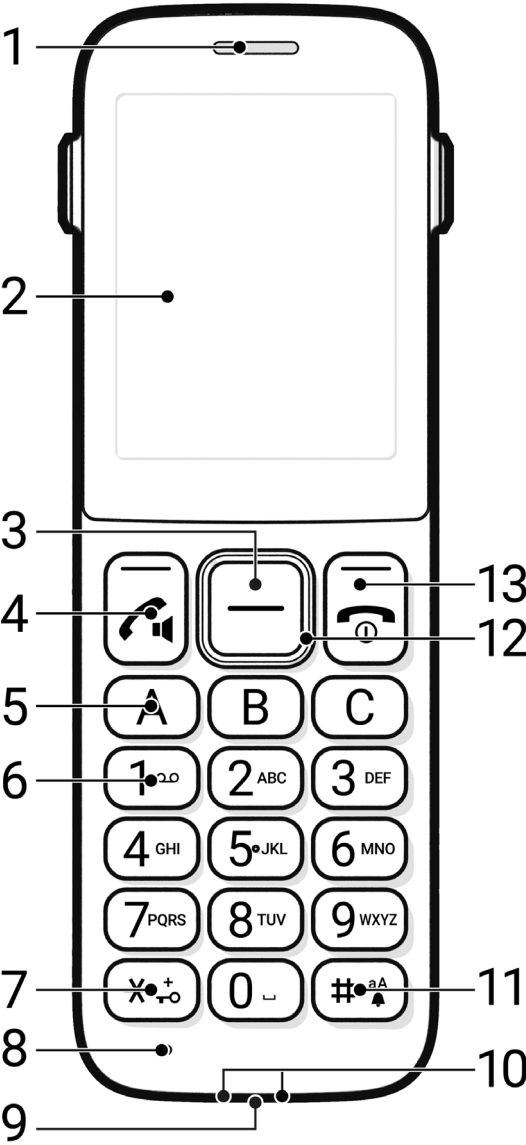

Display texts









Display texts are texts which appear on the display of the mobile phone. Display texts are displayed in **bold print** in this guide.

Example:

Press the **Menu** display key.

Control key

Display of the Control key in the user guide:

-  Press the Navigate Left key.
-  Press the Navigate Up key.
-  Press the Navigate Right key.
-  Press the Navigate Down key.
-  Press the Centre of the Control key.
-  Press on either side of the Control key.
-  Press the Navigate Left or Right key.
-  Press the Navigate Up or Down key.

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Safety instructions

Please read the following instructions carefully. Failure to comply with these instructions may result in personal injury and damage to the device, as well as violations of applicable laws.

Please explain the content of this document as well as the potential risks involved when using the device to your children.

General information

- The mobile phone is splashproof according to the IP44 standard. If your mobile phone has been exposed to water, dry it and the device openings (microphone/loudspeaker/USB Type-C port) with a lint-free cloth to remove any water droplets.
- Permissible temperature range for charging and operation: -10°C to $+60^{\circ}\text{C}$. High temperatures could reduce the service life of electronic devices, damage the battery or deform and melt plastic parts. If the mobile phone is to be used or stored in freezing areas, condensation could develop inside the phone and damage the electronic circuitry.
- Switch off your mobile phone in potentially explosive atmospheres and observe all warnings. Potentially explosive atmospheres also include those locations for which it is normally recommended that vehicle engines be switched off. In such places, flying sparks can cause explosions or fires resulting in personal injury and possibly death. These areas include: Petrol stations, chemical plants, transport or storage areas for hazardous chemicals, areas below deck on ships, areas in which the air contains chemical substances or fine particles (e.g. particles of dust or metal powder).
- Short-circuiting or modifying the mobile phone is prohibited – there is a risk of personal injury, electric shock, fire or damage to the charger.

Battery and charging process

- To avoid battery fluid leakage, overheating, explosion or fire, never incinerate or heat batteries and never dispose of them in a fire or explosion-prone environment. Do not disassemble, weld or modify the battery. Do not store the battery in an environment subject to strong mechanical influences.
- Do not use sharp objects, such as screwdrivers, to touch or puncture the battery. There is a risk of battery fluid leaking, the battery overheating, exploding or catching fire and burning. Crushing, heating or incinerating batteries is strictly prohibited.
- Eye contact with the battery electrolyte can cause blindness. If electrolyte enters the eyes, do not rub the eye with your hand. Immediately flush the affected eye completely with clean water and seek medical attention. There is a risk of skin burns if the electrolyte comes into contact with the skin (or clothing). Immediately rinse the skin or clothing completely with soap and clean water and seek medical attention if necessary.
- Never use the batteries for any purpose other than that specified. Never use a damaged battery. If the battery becomes hot, discoloured, deformed or leaks during use, charging or storage, you must replace the battery with a new one immediately for safety reasons.
- The temperature of the battery rises during charging. Do not store the battery in the same compartment as flammable products – there is a risk of fire.

- The electrical socket must be easily accessible during charging.
- There is a risk of electric shock during a thunderstorm.
- To extend the lifespan of your battery, avoid very high and very low temperatures; the range between 15 and 35°C is optimal.
- It is harmful to keep the battery at 100 % charge for long periods of time.
- Activated wireless connections, such as Bluetooth, increase the power consumption of the device. You can switch them off if they are not needed. Furthermore, the brightness of the display has a significant influence on power consumption. If you set your display to a low brightness level and switch off any wireless connections that are not needed, the device will operate for longer.
- Do not use the charger if the power cable is damaged or there is no battery in the mobile phone – there is a risk of electric shock or a risk of fire in such cases.

Use in hospitals / Medical devices

- The function of medical devices could be impaired if used in the vicinity of your product. Observe the technical conditions in your environment, e.g. in medical practices.
- If you use a medical product (e.g. a pacemaker), consult with the product manufacturer prior to use. They can provide information on the sensitivity of the device with regard to external, high-frequency power sources.
- Pacemakers, implanted cardioverter defibrillators:
When switching on the mobile phone, please pay attention that the distance between the mobile phone and implant is at least 152 mm. To reduce potential interference, use the mobile phone on the opposite side to the implant. In the event of possible interference, please switch the mobile phone off immediately. Do not carry the mobile phone in a shirt pocket.
- Hearing aids, cochlea implants:
Some digital, wireless devices can cause interference in hearing aids and cochlea implants. If interference occurs, please contact the manufacturer of such products.
- Other medical devices:
If you and the people in your environment use other medical devices, please contact the relevant manufacturer as to whether such devices are protected from radio frequency signals in the environment. You can also contact your doctor with regard to this.

Children and pets

- Keep the mobile phone, batteries, chargers and accessories out of reach of children and pets. Children and/or pets may swallow small parts and suffer choking and other hazards. Children may only use the mobile phone when supervised by an adult.

Aircraft, vehicles and road safety

- Switch the mobile phone off in an aircraft.
Please observe the applicable restrictions and regulations.
Wireless devices can interfere with the functionality aeronautical equipment. It is essential to follow instructions from aircraft personnel regarding using the mobile phone on an aircraft.
- As the driver of a vehicle, the main priority is: Safety in road traffic and for road users
Using the mobile phone while driving could distract your attention leading to dangerous situations. In addition, it contravenes current, applicable laws.

SIM card and data connection cables

- Do not remove the card from the mobile phone while sending or receiving data: Doing so increases the risk of loss of data and damage to the mobile phone.

Defective devices

- Installation or repair of the product may only be performed by qualified service personnel.
- Dispose of defective devices or have them repaired by our customer service department; such devices could interfere with other wireless services.
- If the mobile phone is treated roughly, e.g. allowed to fall, the display could break and the electronic circuitry and sensitive interior parts could be damaged.
- Do not use the device if the display is cracked or broken. Glass or plastic splinters can injure the hands and face.
- If the mobile phone, battery or accessories malfunction, please contact your Gigaset Service Centre regarding an inspection.

Further important information

- If the device becomes hot, please put it to one side for a while and cancel any programmes which are being executed at the time. If you come into contact with a device which is hot, there is a risk of slight skin irritation, e.g. redness of the skin.
- Do not paint or varnish the mobile phone. Varnish/Paint could damage parts of the mobile phone and cause operational breakdowns.

First steps

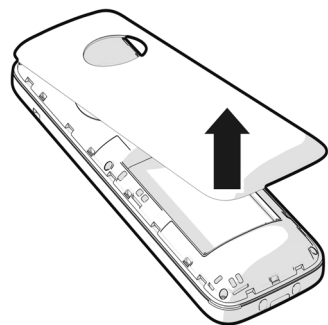

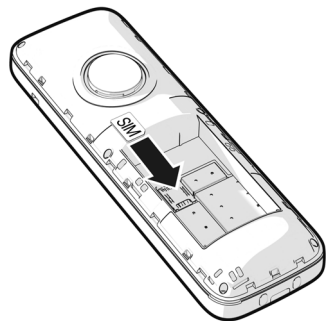
Getting started

Inserting the SIM card

You can insert a nano-SIM card in the mobile phone.

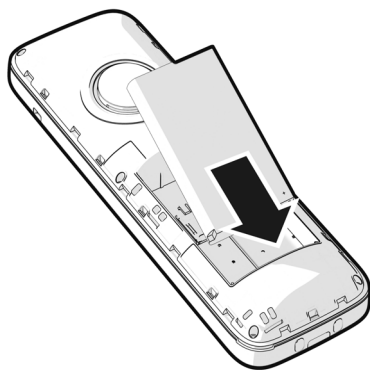


- 1 Insert your fingernail or a suitable aid into the recess in the left-hand corner of the rear side.
- 2 Prise the battery compartment cover upwards to open it.

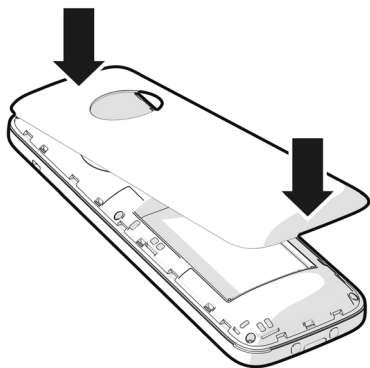


- 1 Insert the SIM card in the left-hand slot. Pay attention that the SIM card is inserted properly aligned.
- ▶ You have inserted a SIM card in the mobile phone.

Inserting the battery and closing the cover

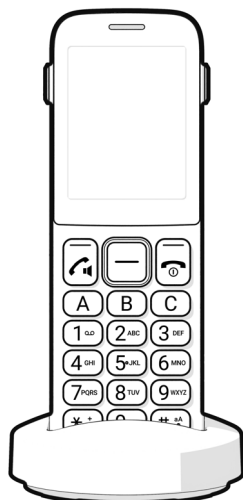


- 1 Insert the battery as illustrated. Pay attention that the battery is inserted properly aligned.




- 1 Replace the battery compartment cover as illustrated.
 - 2 Press the cover down carefully to close it. The battery compartment locks in place with an audible click.
- You have inserted the battery in the mobile phone.

Charging the battery



- 1 Insert the USB plug on the charging cable in the charger.
- 2 Place the mobile phone in the charger.

Ensure the battery is charged fully before starting to use the mobile phone for the first time.

The battery is fully charged when the charge icon  in the icon bar is completely filled.

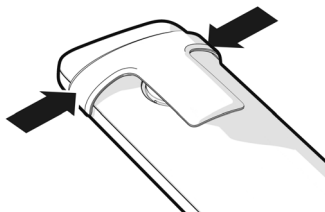


If you have set that the battery should only be charged to 80 %, the charge indicator remains with 4 bars and the battery only charges to 80 %.

Attaching the belt clip

The handset has notches on each side for attaching the belt clip.

- 1 Press the belt clip onto the back of the handset so that the tabs on the belt clip click into place in the notches.



Removing the belt clip


- 1 Press the centre of the belt clip firmly with your right thumb.
- 2 Push the nail of your left thumb up between the clip and the casing.
- 3 Slide the clip upwards to remove.

Operating the mobile phone

This chapter describes the basic steps for operating the mobile phone.

Switching the mobile phone on/off

Switch the mobile phone on:

- 1 Press the right display key **longer**.
- 2 Enter the PIN related to the SIM card inserted using the keypad  on the mobile phone.



The PIN was supplied together with the SIM card by your mobile phone provider. In case of doubt, contact your mobile phone provider.

- 1 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.
- ▶ You have switched on the mobile phone.

Switch the mobile phone off:

- 1 Press the right display key **longer**.
- ▶ You have switched off the mobile phone.

Activating the display


The lighting in the display switches off automatically after 30 seconds (idle status). This function reduces the battery usage of the mobile phone.

- 1 Press any key on the mobile phone.
- ▶ You have switched on the display of the mobile phone.


Switching the keypad lock on/off

The keypad lock inhibits all input via the keys and prevents inadvertent operation of the mobile phone.

Switching on the keypad lock:

- 1 Press the Star key for 2 seconds.
- ▶ You have switched the keypad lock on: The  icon appears in the display.

Switching the keypad lock off:

- 1 Press the left display key.
 - 2 Press the Star key.
- ▶ You have switched the keypad lock off: The  icon disappears.



The keypad lock is deactivated when a call is received. You can accept the call. It then locks again when the call ends.

Please note that when the keypad lock function is activated, no call numbers can be entered.

Using the Control key (Navigation keys)



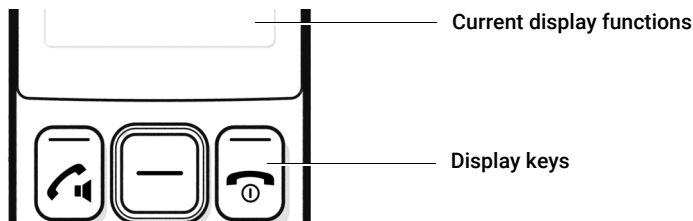
The control key enables you to navigate through the menus and input fields and also to confirm entries. The control key is located between the left display key and the right display key.

Functions of the Control key

In idle status:		Open the menu call lists
		Change audio profile
		Open the menu
		Open the phone book
		Open the menu
During a call		Raise caller volume for the receiver/handsfree function
		Lower caller volume for the receiver/handsfree function
In the menus:		Navigate through the menu

During text input:		Move one text field upwards
		Move one text field downwards

Display keys

The display keys are used to execute the functions indicated in the display. The display functions are indicated at the bottom left and bottom right of the mobile phone display and are dependant on the menu currently displayed.



1 Press the left or right display key.

► You have executed the display functions indicated in the display.

Icons in the status bar

The icons in the status bar at the top edge of the display indicate current settings and the operating status of the mobile phone:



Vibration is activated, ringing tone is deactivated



Silent function is activated



Missed call in call list



Alarm clock is activated



Voice message missed

Wireless communication for SIM card



The number of bars in the icon indicates the quality of the current connection.

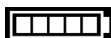
Battery charge status

The bars in the indicator light up in succession during the charging process.

Menu guidance

The mobile phone menu is comprised of a main menu and several submenus.

Main menu

The functions in the main menu are indicated by an icon and a name.

Navigation in the main menu:

- 1 Press the **Menu** display key, the right control key or the centre of the control key.
 - 2 Use the control key to select a submenu (e.g. Settings). The menu currently selected has a coloured background.
 - 3 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.
- You have opened the submenu.

Submenus

The functions in the submenus are displayed in list form.

The menu entry currently selected has a coloured background. If the name of the entry does not fit in one line, the text runs through.

If there are further entries, a scroll bar appears which indicates the position of the entry in the submenu.



Access a function:

- 1 Select a submenu (e.g. Settings).
- 2 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.
- ▶ You have opened the submenu selected.


Switch to previous menu level:

- 1 Press the right display key or the **Back** display key.
- ▶ The previous menu level appears.

Entering text

Press the corresponding button once for each letter (e.g. "Hello" 4 3 5 5 6). The software recognises the word automatically. Use the control keys  /  to switch between the word suggestions.

With "New word" you can select letters by pressing the key with the desired letter several times.

Making/taking calls

This chapter describes the options available with which to use the mobile phone. This includes the various ways to make and take calls. It also includes the description of functions which can be used during a call.



Making calls using the keypad

You can make national and international calls directly using the dialling keys on the mobile phone keypad.

Dial a national phone number:

- 1 Enter the relevant phone number of the contact required, including access code, using the keypad .
 - 2 Press the **Options** display key.
 - 3 Select **Call**.
- You have dialled a phone number using the dialling keypad.

Dial an international phone number:

- 1 Press the Star key  twice, until the + sign is inserted.
 - 2 Enter the relevant phone number of the contact required, including access International dialling code (e.g. +43), using the keypad .
- You have dialled an international phone number.

You can delete digits or cancel dialling a phone number:

Making calls from the phone book

- 1 Press the **Contacts** key in the display.
 - 2 Select the entry required.
 - 3 Press the **Options** display key.
 - 4 Select **Call**.
- You have dialled a phone number from the phone book.

Making calls from a call list

The call lists contain the last calls taken, rejected and missed.

- 1 Press the **Menu** key in the display.
 - 2 Select **Call lists**.
 - 3 Select the required call list.
 - 4 Select the entry required.
 - 5 Press the **Options** display key.
 - 6 Select **Call**.
- You have dialled a phone number from the call list.

Making calls with the direct dialling keys

Dialling a phone number using a direct dialling key

- 1 Press the required direct dialling key A, B or C longer.
 - ▶ You have dialled the phone number assigned to the direct dialling key.

Taking calls

An incoming call is indicated by a ringtone from the mobile phone. The display of the mobile phone shows the phone number of the caller (if transmitted). If the caller is in the phone book, the name assigned appears.

Take a call:

- 1 Press the left display key.
or
 - 1 Press the **Answer** display key.
- ▶ You have taken an incoming call.

Rejecting a call:

- 1 Press the right display key.
or
 - 1 Press the **Reject** display key.
- ▶ You have rejected an incoming call.

Ending a call in progress:

- 1 Press the right display key.
 - ▶ You have ended a phone call which was in progress.

If you do not take an incoming call, it is recorded in the **Missed calls** call list.

During a phone call

The functions described here are available while a phone call is in progress.

Handsfree mode

You can use the loudspeaker of the mobile phone for to make calls (handsfree). This means that you have both hands free during the conversation.

Activate Handsfree mode:

- 1 Press the **Menu** key in the display.
- 2 Select **Hands-free**.
- 3 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.
 - ▶ You have switched Handsfree mode on.
The caller can be heard via the loudspeaker.



Deactivate Handsfree mode:

- 1 Press the **Menu** key in the display.
 - 2 Select **Earpiece**.
 - 3 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.
- You have switched Handsfree mode off.
The caller can be heard via the receiver.
-



Adjusting the loudspeaker during a phone call

The volume of the caller can be adjusted to different levels. The setting adjustment applies for the receiver and loudspeaker for Handsfree mode.

Adjust the volume during a phone call:

- 1 Press the Control key  to raise the volume.
- 2 Press the Control key  to lower the volume.

or

- 1 Press the **Menu** key in the display.
- 2 Select **Adjust volume**.
- 3 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.
- 4 Press the Control key  to raise the volume.
- 5 Press the Control key  to lower the volume.
- 6 Select **Back**.



The setting is automatically saved after about 3 seconds if you have not dialled **Back**.

- You have set the volume for the phone call.
-

Muting the microphone

If the microphone is muted, the caller can no longer hear you.

Mute the microphone:

- 1 Press the **Menu** key in the display.
 - 2 Select **Mute**.
 - 3 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.
- You have muted the microphone.
The caller can no longer hear you.

Switch the microphone back on:

- 1 Press the **Menu** key in the display.
 - 2 Select **Cancel mute**.
 - 3 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.
- You have switched the microphone on.
The caller can hear you again.

Call lists

The mobile phone saves different types of calls (missed, accepted and outgoing calls) in call lists.

Opening a call list

- 1 Press the **Menu** key in the display.
 - 2 Select **Call lists**.
 - 3 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.
- You have opened an overview of the call lists.

The overview of the call lists indicates submenus for every type of call:

- All calls
- Missed calls
- Received calls
- Dialed calls
- Rejected calls

The **All calls** menu contains a summary of the calls of all types of call.

Beside the name of the list is the number of respective entries contained in the list.

- 1 Select the required call list (e.g. missed calls).
 - 2 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.
- You have opened the required call list.

Information on a call

- Phone number or name if the contact is contained in the phone book
- Date and time

Managing the entries in the call lists

- 1 Press the **Menu** key in the display.
- 2 Select **Call lists**.
- 3 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.
- 4 Select the call list required.
- 5 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.
- 6 Select the entry required.
- 7 Press the **Options** key in the display.

 - 7 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.
- You have deleted the call list.

Call timer

- 1 Press the **Menu** key in the display.
 - 2 Select **Call lists**.
 - 3 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.
 - 4 Select **Call timers**.
 - 5 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.
- The following information is shown:

Resetting the call timer

- 1 Press the **Menu** key in the display.
 - 2 Select **Call lists**.
 - 3 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.
 - 4 Select **Call timers**.
 - 5 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.
 - 6 Press the **Reset** key in the display.
 - 7 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.
- You have reset the call timer.

Phone book

The phone book can contain up to 500 entries. Entries can be stored in the internal phone memory or on the SIM card.

You can create phone book entries manually, transfer them from a call list or transfer a phone number to the phone book when dialling it.

Opening the phone book

- 1 Press the **Contacts** key in the display.

or

- 1 Press the **Menu** key in the display.
- 2 Select **Contacts**.
- 3 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.

The **Contacts** display key is always used in the following description.

Phone book entries

The phone book contains all the phone book entries. They are sorted alphabetically.

An entry contains the following information:

- Name

An icon indicates where the phone book entry is stored:

Creating a phone book entry

- 1 Press the **Menu** key in the display.
- 2 Select **Contacts**.
- 3 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.
- 4 Press the **Options** key in the display.
- 5 Select **New**.
- 6 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.
- 7 Select where the new phone book entry should be stored (SIM card or phone memory).
- 8 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.
- 9 Select **Name**.
- 10 Confirm the selection by pressing the Control key .
- 11 Enter the name using the keypad .
- 12 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.
- 13 Select **Mobile** or **Home** number.

- 14 Confirm the selection by pressing the Control key .
- 15 Enter the phone number using the keypad .
- 16 Confirm the selection by pressing the OK key in the display.
- 17 Select **Save**.
 - ▶ You have created a phone book entry.

Searching for a phone book entry

- 1 Enter a letter, numbers or a name using the keypad .
 - ▶ Entries which correspond to the input are displayed.
- or
- 1 Scroll through the list using the Control key .

Making calls from the phone book

- 1 Press the **Menu** key in the display.
- 2 Select **Contacts**.
- 3 Select the entry required.
- 4 Press the **Options** key in the display.
- 5 Select **Call**.
 - ▶ You have dialled the number from the phone book.

Editing/Managing phone book entries

- 1 Select **Contacts**.
- 2 Select the entry required.
- 3 Press the **Options** key in the display.
- 4 Select one of the following options:


Call contact:	▶ Select Call .
Display contact:	▶ Select View contact .
Write a text message (SMS):	▶ Select Write message .
Add contact:	▶ Select New .
Delete a contact	▶ Select Delete .
Delete multiple contacts:	▶ Select Delete multiple .
Copy, import or export contact:	▶ Select Import/Export .
Send V-card:	▶ Select Send vCard .
Add to allow list:	▶ Select Add to Allowlist .
Add to block list:	▶ Select Add to Blocklist .
Group entry:	▶ Select Group .
Further options:	▶ Select Others .

Mailbox

If your phone provider provides you with a mailbox (answering machine), a caller can leave a message for you if you do not take the call.

In order to play and listen to voice messages in your mailbox, you need the phone number of the mailbox. If necessary, ask your mobile service provider with regard to the call number.

You can listen to the messages on the mailbox:

1 Press and hold the  key.


► You have listened to the messages on your mailbox.

Additional functions

SMS (text messages)

You can send and receive text messages (SMS).


- 1 Press the **Menu** key in the display.
- 2 Select **Message**.
- 3 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.

The Control key  is used in the following description.


Writing and sending a text message



A text message can contain up to 612 characters. In the case of more than 160 characters, the text (SMS) is sent as a **chained SMS** (up to 4 individual texts).


- 1 Press the **Menu** key in the display.
- 2 Select **Message**.
- 3 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.
- 4 Select **Write message**.
- 5 Confirm the selection by pressing the Control key .
- 6 Select the recipient of the message 2 different ways:



Enter number:

- 1 Enter the phone number of the contact using the keypad .

or

Using Contacts:

- 1 Press the **Options** key in the display.
- 2 Select **Contacts**.
- 3 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.
- 4 Select the entry required.
- 5 Confirm the selection by pressing the Control key .
- 6 Press the **Options** key in the display.
- 7 Select **OK**.
- 8 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.

- 7 Press the Control key .
 - 8 Enter the text required using the keypad .
 - 9 Confirm the selection by pressing the **OK** key in the display.
 - 10 Press the **Options** key in the display.

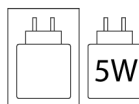
